3. Minutes of Last Meeting

4. Vision for Alcester Projects

Cllr Dearling reported there had been no meeting on the Vision for Alcester Projects since the last Recreation meeting.

5. Conway Fields

- a) The Clerk gave a progress report on the MUGA stating all was complete for the opening on May 13th, except some landscaping alongside the playing field.
- b) The Clerk gave a report re. Alcester Pavilion stating work inside would soon start once the football season had ended. Kitchen equipment from Moorfield School was now available and we would know soon if there was further equipment from the Alcester Hospital site. He stated there was currently £14500 left in the budget from 2009-2010 which would be used to support both this and the natural play project as this work had been expected to have started earlier.
- c) The Clerk gave an update on the Natural Play Area stating Kompan were ready to start the week after the opening of the MUGA. The Funding was in place via SDC who would release the money once invoiced to us.
- d) Cllr Bunting asked councillors to consider future planning applications, fencing and hard standing areas, for such projects as fencing around the play area and a skate park
