**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AT DISCRETION OF CHAIR**

- a) 11/01600/LBC - Proposed external stonework repairs and repointing to the east and north elevation at Town Hall, Church Street for Alcester War Memorial Town Hall Management Committee. *No representation to make.*
- b) 11/01646/TREE - 2 no. willow trees: pollard by 40% at The Community Centre, Malt Mill Lane for Orbit Heart of England Housing Association. *No representation to make.*

**5. Notice of Decision - Permission with conditions**

- a) 11/01419/TREE - 3 no. willow: repollard back to original pollard points. 1 no. ivy-clad dead willow: fell, at Alcester Tennis Club, Moorfield Road. *Noted.*
- b) 10/02686/FUL - Erection of new dwelling on land adjacent to 1 Roebuck Park. *Noted.*

**6. Stratford Road Land**

Committee members had no objection in principle to the use of the land as a temporary car park. Another option could be to relocate the Cadets who were looking for a new site. A decision needed to be made on whether to have the concrete slabs removed or bring the levels up around the slabs. Cllr Cargill agreed to approach the contractors carrying out the sewerage improvement scheme to see if they would carry out this work or work to the car park at the Pavilion, and agreed to take measurements and cost out the work. Cllr Bunting reported that grants were being sought for finishing the Pavilion and he would also check what funds would be left for the work.
