1. Apologies

The Clerk gave a report that no further progress had been reported.

5. Globe House

The Clerk gave a report stating on May 8th insufficient financial information was available for a decision and a later deadline of May 23rd had been agreed. Late that day an e-mail had been received from the County Council head of Property Services stating a financial shortfall in the plans which had been agreed between the County Council and the Museum. The clerk had responded to this with an alternative option (3) with a letter detailing how this may work financially giving a future option for the Town Council Office to be located in Globe House. This had been accepted positively and further talks were ongoing.

6. Alcester Neighbourhood Plan

The Clerk gave a report on recent meetings with local Parish Councils and outlined the foreseeable activities of the Alcester Neighbourhood Plan Team with respect to the Community engagement Programme.
