# The 2015 Alcester Community Town Plan and Neighbourhood Development Plan Household Questionnaire

#### Town Community plan

In 2006 the Town Council, working with the neighboring parishes, circulated a questionnaire to every household in Alcester for residents to respond with what they thought the needs of the town were, it identified the need for more youth facilities and better access to doctors, when it was adopted in 2008 by SDC the results of this survey were used to enable the town to secure funding for a Youth Club and have its doctors surgeries updated into a purpose built new building. Nine years on and its time we repeated the process to make sure the needs of the residents are once again identified.

### Neighbourhood Plan

Following the Community engagement events last year the Town Council would now like to know whether residents think the issues identified so far are the right ones, and what people think about the proposed aims and vision for the town. We would also like to find out some further details about specific issues, such as the town centre, new development, the environment, and community facilities in Alcester. This information will be used to prepare policies and proposals which Stratford-on-Avon District Council will use to make planning decisions in Alcester, after the Neighbourhood Plan has been successful in the referendum.
