## **The Great Pilgrimage 90**

Last year The RBL recreated its 1928 pilgrimage to World War One battlefields in Belgium and France for thousands of Legion members.

GP90 was the biggest membership event in the Legion's history.

A decade after the end of WW1, veterans and war widows visited the battlefields of the Somme and Ypres before marching to the Menin Gate in Ypres on 8 August 1928.

On 8 August 2018, two representatives from every branch and county or their local community marched along the same route in Ypres to the Menin Gate, representing an entire generation that served while defending their country.

Our representatives—Mike Clark and Nick Dearling will tell us of their personal experience of GP90. This will include a 20 minute film of the event and light refreshments.
