**NEW PEDESTRIAN
LAYOUT FOR SOCIAL
DISTANCING**

ALCESTER HIGH STREET

The scheme includes:

One-way pavement pedestrian flow on HIGH STREET

- BEGINS ON THE WEST SIDE AT St NICHOLAS CHURCH HEADING SOUTH PAST SIMPLY FRESH TOWARDS STRATFORD ROAD WHERE IT ENDS
- BEGINS ON THE EAST SIDE AT STRATFORD ROAD HEADING NORTH PAST THE UNIONIST CLUB TOWARDS CHURCH STREET WHERE IT ENDS

Partial Two-way pavement pedestrian flow on HIGH STREET

- BEGINS ON THE WEST SIDE AT STRATFORD ROAD HEADING NORTH ENDING AT LLOYDS PHARMACY
- BEGINS ON THE EAST SIDE AT SPECSAVERS HEADING SOUTH ENDING AT STRATFORD ROAD

ALL THREE RAISED HUMPS ACROSS HIGH STREET ARE TWO-WAY PEDESTRIAN FLOW

The Tuery's

- HIGH STREET TO WAITROSE AND CARPARK IS **TWO-WAY** PEDESTRIAN FLOW
- HIGH STREET BY ROYAL OAK TO GAS HOUSE LANE IS **TWO-WAY** PEDESTRIAN FLOW
- HIGH STREET TO BULLS HEAD YARD IS **NO ENTRY**
- BULLS HEAD YARD TO HIGH STREET IS **ONE-WAY** ONLY

PARTIALLY SIGHTED PEDESTRIANS AND THOSE WITH GUIDE DOGS ARE NOT BOUND BY THESE LAYOUT CHANGES. PLEASE BE PREPARED TO GIVE WAY IF NECESSARY

PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO AND OBSERVE INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED ON SIGNS AND BY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

THERE ARE NO CHANGES TO HIGH STREET PARKING OR TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS

Stratford Road, Church Street, Butter Street and Henley Street are unaffected by this scheme
