MEETING NOTES – 25TH OCTOBER 2023

Notes from Meeting

- 1. Wendy Mills was elected Chair of the Working Group
- 2. Wendy Mills gave an update on the background:
 - Squash courts acquired by ATC in April 2021 as part of the 125 year lease of the Greig Hall from SDC.
 - Survey in August 2023 indicated that the fascia cladding was falling off and there was water ingress inside the courts.
 - ATC own the building therefore under Occupiers Liability Act, the Council is responsible for any injury. Action is therefore required.
- 3. Options are as follows:
 - Demolish the squash courts estimate cost £50,000
 - Redevelop as a community building.

Funds are only available for the latter option.

- 4. Very positive feedback from the community at the prospect of a Men's Shed. Primary aim to support men's mental health.
- 5. Repair Café has been really successful and many of the attendees are interested in the prospect of a Shed.
- 6. Alcester Community Shed has been constituted and has a bank account. They just need premises.
- 7. More environmentally friendly to convert an existing building than to build a new one.
- 8. An anonymous donor has given substantial funds to ATC to redevelop the squash courts as a Men's Shed.
- 9. Mark Cargill gave an update on the quotes and estimates he has already obtained and requested. He outlined the list of work required.

- 10. The roof needs to be dealt with urgently as it is leaking. A tender document had been issued on the Contracts Finder website with a closing date of Friday 27th October. The tenders will be opened on Monday 30th October with a proposal to F & GP on 31st October.
- 11. The draft business case and options paper were discussed.
- 12. It was agreed that the project should be managed by ATC in the same way as the Greig Hall redevelopment had been run.
- 13. Costs of the project were discussed.
- 14. It was agreed that a motion would be put to Full Council as set out in the draft business case.
- 15. Subject to this motion passing, there would be a further motion to award the roofing contract.
- 16. Next meeting 1 pm on Wednesday 8th November at Globe House.
