Using Vanessa's notes from meeting on 14th November, all items were agreed and/or complete except the following:

1. Sand and sandbag supplies

Vanessa will ask Tim Forman to look at options for a larger container for sand at School Road which can be kept full and ready for an emergency. It was agreed to keep a supplementary supply at Centenary Field as currently.

2. Communications

- a. It was agreed to produce an A5 leaflet for residents. Vanessa will draft and share with the group.
- b. Leaflet to be distributed to houses with possibility of flooding Susan Juned to be asked for a list.
- c. Leaflet to be distributed to schools.
- d. Wendy Sherwood to be asked to make contact with vulnerable properties (Malin Court etc) and offer leaflet.
- e. Discussions regarding a pop-up banner for ATC which could be used for multiple events Vanessa will check what is already in the EPCC loft.
- f. Communications Working Group to be asked to include regular messaging about flooding in newsletter and social media.
- g. Flood Group to report to Full Council in January.

3. Flood Fair

Plans to hold a flood fair in Autumn 2024. Suggestions required as to who to invite. Possibly sign up to the National Flood Forum.

4. Community Emergency Plan

Sarah Duran to update as usual.

5. Community Flood Plan

Sub-group formed of Andrew, Corin and Clive to update plan. Discussion about the document forming a Flood Warden handbook. Important for this Sub-Group to decide how messages are sent out via WhatsApp to establish lines of authority. Set up "gold command" structure?

6. Flood Wardens

New recruitment drive after Community Flood Plan complete. Training to be planned.
